Understanding the Fair Prize Money Ruling

The Fair Prize Money ruling is a document that protects, teams, buyers, buy-ins and the Sole Proprietorship from unfair money depositories. Fair Prize Money Ruling is an overseer that states a Guaranteed Prize Pool must be stated before the Tournament, or League starts. The Prize Pool can not be deducted but can be raised per the NAOLeague Sole Proprietorship. The Fair Prize Money states that the NAOLeague must give earnings to teams, persons, buyers per Prize Pool Rules/Statues.

How does the Fair Prize Money Ruling protect me?

Fair Prize Money Ruling allows you to understand the consequences if the NAOLeague breaks and does not properly deposit the money to you. The NAOLeague is solely responsible for all payments to the teams, persons completely.

I have not been given my earnings the day of the League or Match is over, what do I do?

The NAOLeague states that all payments will be sent via PayPal directly in 24-72hrs of ending of Tournament/League end. If none has been sent, please contact sales@nexgaming.com for more information. If nothing has been done in a week from NAOLeague, you are allowed to file a complaint with the State of Indiana.
